Our team is committed to delivering inclusive and non-judgemental sexual health promotion and outreach across Nottingham and Nottinghamshire. We focus on empowering people—especially individuals whose needs aren't met by traditional healthcare approaches—to build healthy relationships and make informed choices that support positive sexual health. By working collaboratively with partners and communities, we aim to reduce sexual health inequalities and improve outcomes for those most at-risk.

What we are trying to achieve

Empower people to make informed choices - We provide clear, confidential advice so individuals and communities can lead healthy sexual lives.	Work with communities, not just for them - We co-produce outreach and resources with local organisations and people, making sure our work reflects real needs.
Make services easier to find and use - We promote and signpost all local sexual health services, so people know what's available and how to access it.	Tackle stigma and open up conversations - We create safe, respectful spaces for talking about sexual health — helping people feel confident, informed, and supported
Support access to contraception - We raise awareness of the C-card scheme and contraception options and make it easier for young people to register and pick up condoms.	Reach people who need us most - We focus our outreach on communities and areas facing health inequalities, using data and local knowledge to guide where and how we work.
Increase access to testing We bring testing into communities, prioritising those most affected by poor sexual health outcomes.	Build knowledge across the system We help other teams and services feel confident talking about sexual health and supporting people with the right information.

Priority Populations

Young People (16-24), Severe Multiple Disadvantage, Gay Bisexual (all) Men who have Sex with Men, asylum seekers/those newly arrived in the country, black African communities and Asian and British Asian populations

What we can offer

-  **Community Testing** We offer free, confidential asymptomatic STI testing in communities, focusing on those most affected by poor sexual health.
-  **C-Card and Contraception Access** We promote and deliver awareness the C-card scheme (free condoms), and raise awareness of all forms of contraception available locally, including where and how to access them, helping young people access free condoms and advice.
-  **Service Signposting** We make it easier for people to find and use local sexual health services — through clear, inclusive promotion.
-  **Direct Delivery** We provide clear, inclusive sexual health information to help people make informed choices, protect themselves and access the support they need — delivered in a range of settings including community spaces, outreach events, and partner organisations.
-  **Support for Those Most at Risk** We work 1:1 and in small groups with people at highest risk — covering sexual health basics, safer sex, and how to access services.
-  **Co-Production with Communities** We design outreach and resources with local people and organisations — making sure our work reflects real needs.
-  **Training for Professionals** We deliver training, briefings, and resources to help staff feel confident talking about sexual health with the people they support.
